Take the train (ÖBB) to Jenbach station and from there another 35km on the Zillertalbahn to Mayrhofen. From here, take a taxi or one of the local buses to reach our house or our mountain hut.

Motorway:

You can reach us from neighbouring countries via the Tyrolean Inntal motorway. Stay on the A12 motorway until the Zillertal exit and then follow the Zillertal Bundesstraße (B169) for approx. 30 km until shortly before Mayrhofen. Approx. 1km before the "Mayrhofen" town sign, turn left and drive through the tunnel in the direction of "Brandberg". Directly after the tunnel, turn left for the Häusling Alm inn in the direction of "Zillergrund" (no toll for our guests!). Do not turn left to Haus Alpenland, but turn right - always in the direction of Brandberg. Once in the village, drive straight ahead until you see our house on the left after approx. 150 metres.

Please note the following information when you arrive:



Apart Edelweiss - separate entrance door

Apart Alpenrose - entrance is on the right side, stairs upwards

Apart Enzian - entrance is on the right side, flat is on the ground floor.

Please do not lock the entrance door to the Alpenrose and Enzian apartments. They still have separate apartment doors with their own key. This is located directly on the door on the day of arrival.

How the check-out works

Before you leave the flat, please note the following:

We would ask you to pay the room bill one day before departure by 17:00 at the latest.

Please note our times:

We can guarantee a check-in from **14:00 to 20:00**. Should you arrive later than 20:00, please let us know.

Check-out must take place by **09:00 h** on the day of departure. Please note that we will charge extra costs for late check-out if this has not been agreed.

Information about the accommodation and the house rules

A few house rules apply to the use of our holiday flat.



House rules:

- Please rest after 21:00!
- Switch off the lights and all electronic devices when leaving the flat.
- Please do not switch off the radiators, you can like to regulate up and down yourself.
- Wednesday is a day off - no guest service. This does not apply to breakfast
- Breakfast is served from 7.30 am to 10.30 am.
- If you would like to join us for dinner, please let us know the day before.
- Hot meals from 11:30 am to 7:00 pm
- If there are more than one person in the flat, please do not bring any furniture, crockery or other items. We ask for your understanding.
- If it happens to you that something breaks, please don't be shy and let us know. It can happen to anyone and we will certainly find a solution.

Of course, we want you to have a great time anyway, so we'll explain everything you need to know about our holiday flat amenities and how everything works!

Instructions for use

In our holiday flat we separate our waste and for the sake of the environment we ask you to do the same! We will be happy to explain to you what you need to look out for.

Waste separation:

Our large collection point is located in the entrance area to the Apartments Alpenrose and Enzian.

We have different containers to separate waste. If you follow the two easy steps, we should all be happy:

1. Sort your waste:

We have a white bucket under the sink for organic waste and the bucket for plastic is attached to the inside under the sink.

Please dispose of residual waste, glass and cans at the collection point.

1. Take out the rubbish when it is full:

We will of course clean the holiday flat at the end, but we would be happy if we didn't have to play dustman. We would therefore ask you to take the rubbish bags to the containers at the above-mentioned location as soon as they are full. If the organic waste is full, please let us know so that we can dispose of it.

You are welcome to pick up new bin liners from us at the inn.

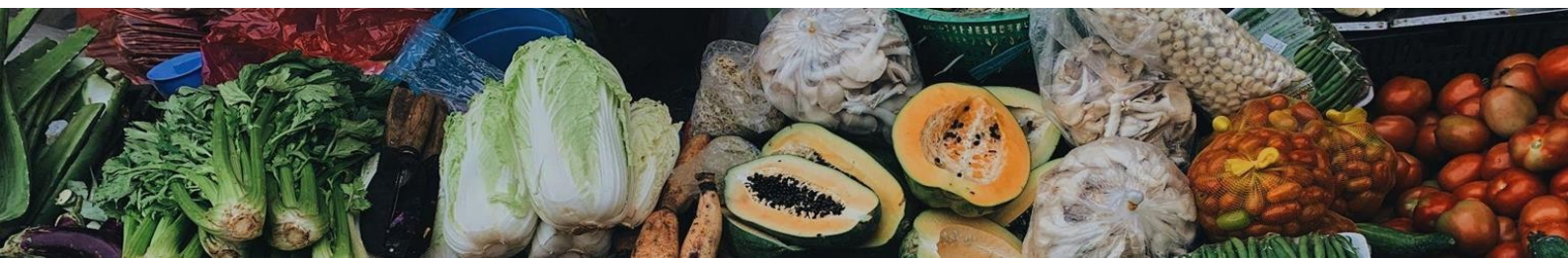
If the waste is not separated correctly, we will charge you extra costs of 100,00 € will be charged.

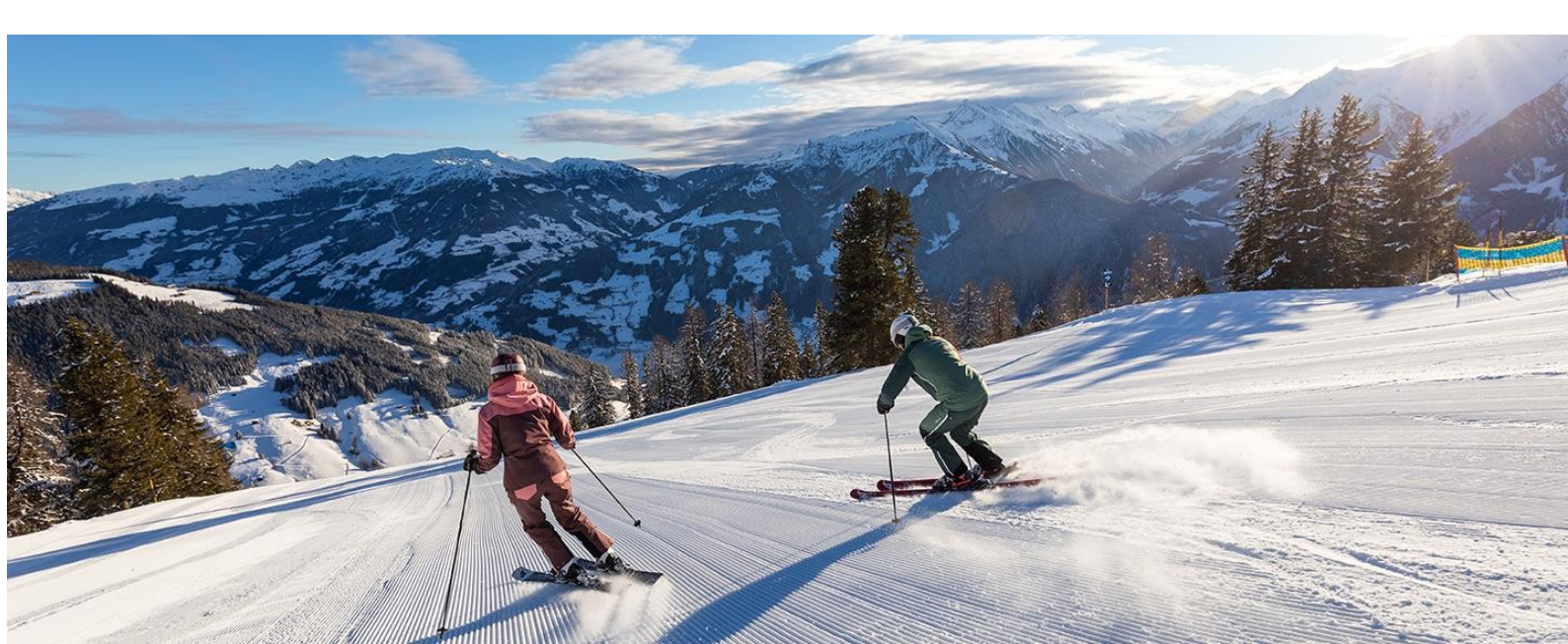

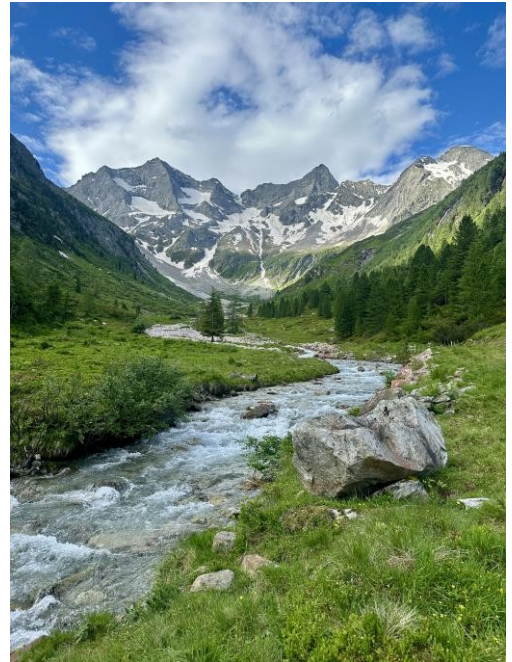
Activities

1. Activity 1

Hike to the Bodenalm Walking

time: approx. 2 h

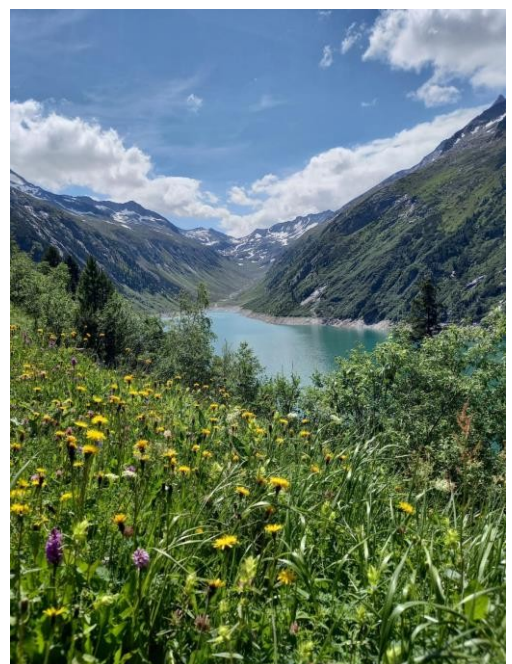
You can start your hike directly in front of our holiday home. After the power station, turn right over the bridge and the hiking trail starts behind the stable. A real insider tip where you can really enjoy the peace and quiet!



1. activity 2

Hike to Hohenau Alm - "Little Tibet" Walking time from the top of the dam wall: approx. 1.5 hours As there is a bus stop in front of our house, you can take the bus up to the dam wall and start the hike along the reservoir to "Little Tibet".

Can also be used with a pushchair or bicycle. You can also drive to the Bärenbadalm by car. Park there and set off on foot, by bus or by bike.

AdlerBühne Ahorn in summer

This attraction is definitely worth a visit. Whether big or small. The Wechselberger family, who look after the eagle stage, offer a show from eagles, buzzards to eagle owls and the like that you will certainly not find anywhere else in the Zillertal Alps.

There is a suitable programme for everyone at the Mayrhofen adventure pool in the Zillertal.

Whether in an outdoor or indoor pool, swimming is one of the healthiest sports there is. When swimming, almost all muscles are used and supplied with oxygen. Swimming means movement without strain, as the force of gravity is reduced by the buoyancy in the water. Intervertebral discs and joints are moved without pressure - the core muscles are strengthened.

A mountain pasture is not a petting zoo!

A certain amount of caution is required when encountering alpine cattle. In order to avoid dangerous situations, some information about the behaviour of the different animals should be known.

Cattle herds can be divided into three types based on their composition:

Suckler cow herd

This consists of mother cows and their calves. The mother cows have a strong protective instinct and impulsively defend their calves! If adult males (bulls) are also present, special care must be taken!

Herd of young animals

These younger animals are above all high-spirited, very eager to move and curious. They are not aggressive, but their exuberance can quickly lead to uncontrolled movements!

Herd of cows

The classic "dairy cow" is used to intensive contact with humans, after all she is milked every day! Nevertheless, she wants to graze undisturbed and enjoy the alpine summer

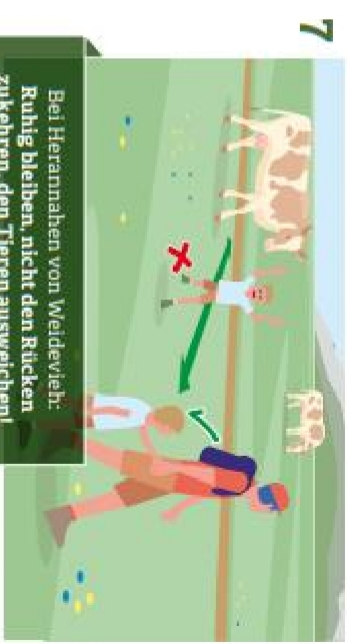

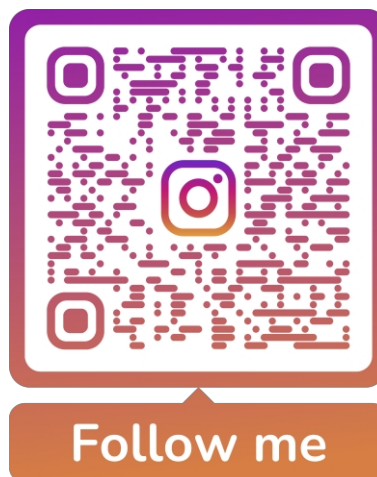
